PLACES TO VISIT

Centre for Aromatic Plants

Centre for Aromatic Plants (CAP) has established by the Government of Uttarakhand in 2003 in industrial area Selaqui, Dehradun. CAP equipped with end to end facilities and support services like survey, training, research, production of quality planting material, extension, distillation, and marketing, etc.

Centre for Excellence for Aromatic Crops

To support the extension program high-tech nursery has been established to produce a bulk quantity of quality planting material. In high tech nursery, one high tech Green House and 3 Net House are equipped with a germination chamber, automation and fertigation system, boom irrigation drip irrigation, foggers and weather station.



Aroma Garden

More than 20 aromatic crops can be seen at aroma Garden. The major species are different varieties of lemongrass, Damask Rose, Citronella, Mints, Chamomile, Stevia, Basil, Ginger Grass, Gania Grass, Kalabansa, Van Tulsi, Jwarancosa, Palmarosa, lemon balm, perilla, oregano, thyme, Hemp, Bela, Chameli, Juhi, Artemisia Annuua, Artmesia vulgaris, Butch, Nagarmotha Mornada etc.

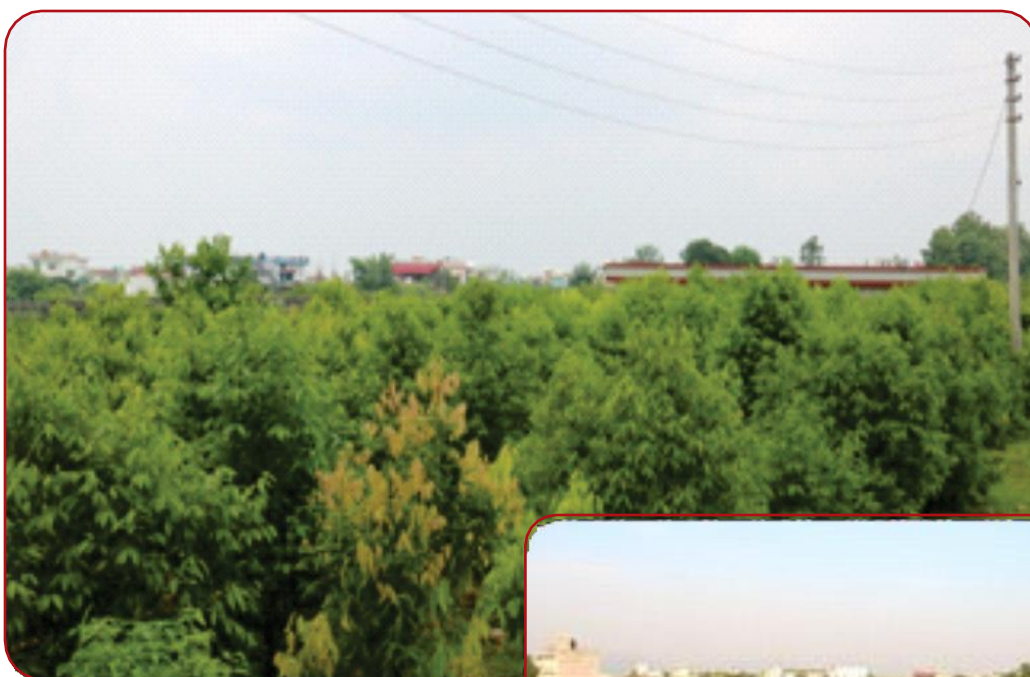

Places to Visit in Rishikesh

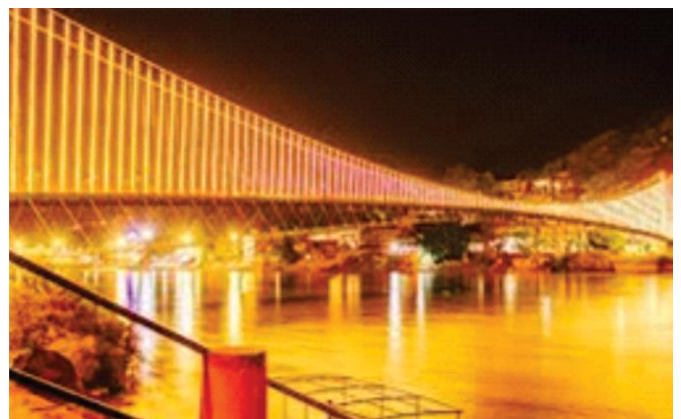
Ganga Aarti at Parmarth Niketan

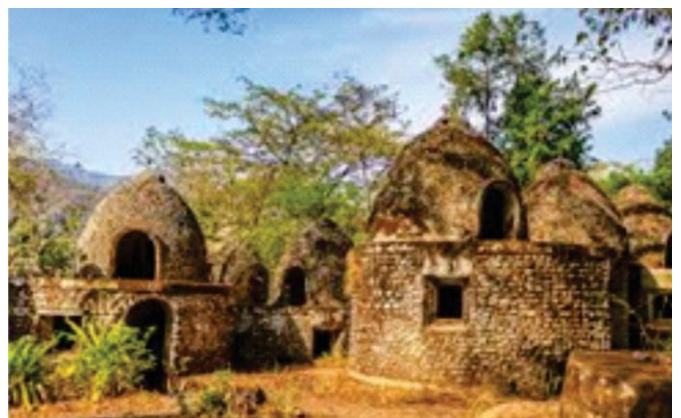
Janki Setu
